## IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

## A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** rehabilitation housing standards in regards to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) application for tribal member housing rehabilitation.

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation is required to adopt standard housing quality conditions for the rehabilitation of homes conducted with any awarded ICDBG and IHBG/NAHASDA monies for the rehabilitation of privately owned tribal member homes for the duration of the grant award,

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma this Bill be cited as approval of standard housing conditions that provide for: (a) a safe house, in physically sound condition with all systems performing their intended design functions; (b) a livable home environment that is energy efficient and incorporates energy conservation measures; and, (c) provides adequate space and privacy for all intended household members
