WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services is accepting applications for funding of the FY/2017 LIHEA Program, and

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation LIHEA Program will be operated as in the past to assist low income households with home heating or cooling bills, in accordance with the Plan.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for the FY/2017 LIHEAP Plan, under the conditions described herein.
