

TO APPROVE RIGHT OF WAY NO. T-150 (RENEWAL OF T-44 AND M-1731) WITH ONEOK GAS TRANSPORTATION, LLC, ON LAND USA IN TRUST FOR THE CHOCTAW AND CHICKSAW NATIONS IN LATIMER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION  
ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** Right of Way No. T-150 (renewal of T-44 and M-1731) with ONEOK Gas Transportation, LLC (ONEOK), in Latimer County, Oklahoma.

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Chief shall perform all duties pertaining to the Office of the Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation, and

**WHEREAS,** ONEOK has proposed a right of way renewal for an existing 8" diameter steel pipeline for the transportation of natural gas on land USA in Trust for the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations located in part of the N½ SE¼ and W½ SW¼ SE¼ of Section 5, Township 6 North, Range 21 East, Latimer County, Oklahoma, containing 1490 feet or 90.30 rods, as shown on the attached survey plat marked Exhibit A; and


**WHEREAS,** ONEOK has agreed to pay the appraised value of \$100 per rod, for a total consideration payment of \$9,030.00. The proposed easement will be for a term of twenty (20) years with a beginning date of July 3, 2013 (it will be back-dated to the expiration date of Right of Way No. T-44). There will be no change in the width or length of the original easement.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval of the proposed Right of Way No. T-150 (renewal of T-44 and M-1731) in favor of ONEOK on land USA in Trust for the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations located in Latimer County, Oklahoma.

**CERTIFICATION**
