A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Interior for the Energy and Mineral Development Program - Solar Power.

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Interior will assist the Choctaw Nation to assess the value and feasibility of developing solar power to benefit members and stakeholders of the Choctaw Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Energy and Mineral Development Program grant proposal is being submitted to the Division of Energy and Mineral Development on behalf of Choctaw Nation; and


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation is willing to consider developing any potential energy and mineral resource discovered, and


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation will consider public release of non-proprietary data or reports obtained by the Energy and Mineral Development Program - Solar Power.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Interior for the Energy and Mineral Development Program - Solar Power.

CERTIFICATION
