

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE 2015 METHAMPHETAMINE AND SUICIDE PREVENTION INITIATIVE – GENERATION INDIGENOUS INITIATIVE SUPPORT

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative – Generation Indigenous Initiative Support.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has retroactively awarded the Choctaw Nation a grant that was initially submitted in 2015 and not funded as a result of an error by the United States Department of Health and Human Services. The Choctaw Nation will receive the grant award in the amount of \$175,000 to promote early intervention strategies and implement positive youth and development; and

WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$175,000 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative – Generation Indigenous Initiative Support from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in increasing prevention activities for youth by using evidence based practices to build resiliency, promote positive development, and increase self-sufficiency behaviors among native youth.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget for the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative – Generation Indigenous Initiative Support.
