

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the Oklahoma District Attorneys Council for the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the Oklahoma District Attorneys Council in the amount of \$86,340 to continue to expand and enhance victims of crime services; and

WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$86,340 with a required match of tribal funds in the amount of \$4,544, which is budgeted in the FY17 Choctaw Nation General Fund Budget Council Bill; and

WHEREAS, funds for the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant from the Oklahoma District Attorneys Council will assist the Choctaw Nation in providing services to victims of elder/vulnerable adult abuse.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget for the Oklahoma District Attorneys Council for the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant.

CERTIFICATION
