IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Three Continuation for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative Purpose Area 2 - Project Path of Hope.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Health and Human Services for budget period September 30, 2017 through September 29, 2018 in the amount of \$175,000 to provide suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention resources for Native Americans; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$175,000 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the Year Three Continuation for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative - Project Path of Hope from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in identifying and addressing suicide ideations, attempts, and contagions through the development and implementation of culturally appropriate and community relevant prevention, intervention, and postvention strategies by promoting positive youth development and family engagement through strategies to reduce risk factors for suicidal behavior.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Three Continuation for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative Purpose Area 2 - Project Path of Hope.
