

TO APPROVE THE CHOCTAW NATION AND THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA TO ENTER INTO A HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE COMPACT

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma and the State of Oklahoma Hunting and Fishing License Compact of 2016.

WHEREAS pursuant to article VIII Section I of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma to wit: "The legislative authority of the Choctaw Nation shall be vested in the Tribal Council";

WHEREAS pursuant to article VII Section I of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma to wit: "The Chief shall perform all duties appertaining to the office of Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation. He shall take care that the laws be faithfully executed";

WHEREAS the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma's representatives have negotiated with the State of Oklahoma on a Hunting and Fishing License Compact; and

WHEREAS an agreement has been reached between the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma and the State of Oklahoma.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval of authority for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Hunting and Fishing License Compact.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that twelve (12) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Regular Session of the Tribal Council at Tuskahoma, Oklahoma on August 13, 2016. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB- 137-16 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of twelve (12) members, zero (0) negative votes, and zero (0) abstaining.
