IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE assistance to local churches for improvements and/or the general welfare of the church.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma agrees to donate funds to churches located within the 10 ½ counties of the Choctaw Nation no to exceed the amount set below for assistance to churches; and

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation wishes to assist the Choctaw people in their community efforts and such assistance to local churches would benefit numerous people; and

WHEREAS, each member of the Tribal Council shall have the discretion to allocate up to Ten Thousand (\$10,000.) each year to churches within their respective districts; and

WHEREAS, this funding shall be for the purpose of improvements and/or the general welfare of the church; and

WHEREAS, upon request, a statement will be provided regarding expenditures or verification of expenditures for the donation from the Choctaw Nation for the improvements and/or the general welfare of the church; and


WHEREAS, CB-76-01 and CB-102-00 are hereby rescinded.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for the assistance to churches located within the 10 ½ counties of the Choctaw Nation.

APPROVE WATER AND SEWER SERVICES FOR RURAL CHURCHES

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

CHARLOTTE JACKSON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING

A COUNCIL BILL

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma agrees to provide matching funds, dollar for dollar, up to but not to exceed \$2,500.00, for the purpose of providing water and sewer services to rural churches within the 10 ½ counties of the Choctaw Nation having a large number of Choctaw members, and

WHEREAS, this funding shall be limited to the purpose of providing water and sewer services, and said churches must provide documentation to verify that they have expended or are expending the same amount requested from the Choctaw Nation.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED, by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this act be cited as approval to provide matching funds, dollar for dollar, up to but not to exceed \$2,500.00, to provide water and sewer services to rural churches having a large number of Choctaw members, under the conditions described herein.

CHARLOTTE JACKSON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING

A COUNCIL BILL

To approve monies to assist with building repairs for twenty-four (24) Indian churches within the Choctaw Nation. Each council member will select two churches from his/her district.

Whereas, the Choctaw Nation wishes to assist the Choctaw people in their community efforts, and


Whereas, these repairs and sanitary systems would benefit a numerous amount of people, and


Whereas, the Choctaw Nation will approve an amount up to but not to exceed \$2,500 per church with proof of receipt for materials and/or supplies toward construction or improvement for each church.


Therefore be it enacted by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval of an amount not to exceed \$2,500 per church from the Motor Fuel Tax Fund to assist these churches with building repairs, under the conditions described herein.
