A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for the Strengthening the Public's and/or K-12 Students' Environmental Literacy for Community Resilience.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to strengthen environmental literacy to enable informed decision-making necessary for community resilience to extreme weather events and other environmental hazards, and

WHEREAS, funds from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration will assist the Choctaw Nation in the design and purchase of a trailer to be used as a mobile education unit that will be taken to schools, community centers, Labor Day and other similar events to educate people regarding environmental issues and how they can make a difference.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for the Strengthening the Public's and/or K-12 Students' Environmental Literacy for Community Resilience.
