TO APPROVE THE CHIEF AND TRIBAL COUNCIL ELECTION ORDINANCE

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the Chief and Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Election Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma requires the Tribal Council to prescribe election procedures and regulations for Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma elections; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation that the Election Ordinance established in CB-39-17 be replaced; and

WHEREAS, this Chief and Tribal Council Election Ordinance is enacted by the Tribal Council to supersede all previous election ordinances, laws and regulations, pursuant to and consistent with Article IX, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to replace the Election Ordinance as previously enacted in CB-39-17 and as approval of the new Election Ordinance as attached herein.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that Ten (10) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Special Session of the Tribal Council at Tuskahoma, Oklahoma on February 23, 2017. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB- 60 -17 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of Seven (7) members, One (1) negative votes, and Two (2) abstaining.
