RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the National Association of County and City Health Officials for the Medical Reserve Corps Challenge Awards.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the National Association of County and City Health Officials for budget period January 30, 2017 to March 31, 2018 in the amount of \$13,000 to assist in strengthening community health education; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$13,000 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds for the Medical Reserve Corps Challenge Awards from the National Association of County and City Health Officials will assist the Choctaw Nation in the Skin Deep Initiative which is designed to address inadequate education associated with mosquito risks and over-exposure to the sun.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget for the National Association of County and City Health Officials for the Medical Reserve Corps Challenge Awards.

CERTIFICATION
