

TO APPROVE A ROAD AND UTILITY EASEMENT IN FAVOR OF THE CITY OF CALERA ON CHOCTAW TRIBAL FEE LAND IN BRYAN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE a road and utility easement in favor of the City of Calera on Choctaw Tribal Fee land in Bryan County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Chief shall perform all duties pertaining to the Office of the Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation, and

WHEREAS, the easement is described as a 40 foot-wide non-exclusive road and utility easement lying within the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 14, Township 7 South, Range 8 East, Bryan County, Oklahoma, more particularly described on the attached Exhibit A and Survey Plat. The easement will be for a perpetual term. The Choctaw Nation agrees to accept payment in the amount of \$10.00.

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed easement, Exhibit A, and survey plat are attached hereto.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval of the proposed Road and Utility Easement in favor of the City of Calera on Choctaw Tribal Fee land in Bryan County, Oklahoma.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum.
