

TO APPROVE A REQUEST THAT THE SECRETARY OF THE ELECTION BOARD ESTABLISH
ADDITIONAL VOTING LOCATIONS FOR THE 2017 TRIBAL ELECTION

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE a request that the Secretary of the Election Board establish additional Voting Locations for the 2017 Tribal Election.

WHEREAS, CB-60-17 enacted the current Chief and Tribal Council Election Ordinance of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned election ordinance was approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs on February 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XI, Section 2, the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma may request the Secretary of the Election Board designate additional Voting Locations; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires for the Secretary of the Election Board to designate 10 additional Voting Locations to be established for the 2017 Tribal Election; more specifically, 3 additional Voting Location/s to be established in District 4, 3 additional Voting Location/s to be established in District 6, 3 additional Voting Location/s to be established in District 7, and 1 additional Voting Location/s to be established in District 9; and the Tribal Council further recommends that the locations listed on "Exhibit A" be established for the 2017 Tribal Election; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requesting Early Voting be open at 5 additional Voting Locations as designated on "Exhibit A" the as well as Election Day.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to request that the Secretary of the Election Board establish 10 additional Voting Locations, as delineated above, be opened for Early Voting and Election Day during the 2017 Tribal Election of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that eleven (11) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Regular Session of the Tribal Council at Tuskahoma, Oklahoma on May 13, 2017. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB- 85 -17 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of eleven (11) members, zero (0) negative votes, and zero (0) abstaining.
