IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Environmental Regulatory Enhancement Grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to achieve environmentally healthy, sustainable communities; and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma ("CNO") by increasing the capacity of the Choctaw Environmental Protection Services Program with developing standard operating procedures, policies, training materials, fillable forms, and other administrative materials; implementing an environmental permit management software; attend trainings to increase knowledge base and expertise; and outreach to CNO facility and business stakeholders.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Environmental Regulatory Enhancement Grant.
