IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation for the FY20 Tribal Resilience Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, for budget period June 1, 2020 through May 31, 2022, in the amount of \$109,444.00 to host technical and training workshops utilizing the RiverWare software. See Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the federal budget for the FY20 Tribal Resilience Cooperative Agreement is \$109,444.00 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds will be used to train RiverWare software users to support the development of adequate hydrologic models as required by the Nation's water settlement.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept One Hundred Nine Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$109,444.00) from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, for the FY20 Tribal Resilience Cooperative Agreement for budget period June 1, 2020 through May 31, 2022.
