A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, for the FY22 Domestic Violence Prevention Program: Forensic Healthcare Services (DVP:FHC).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") seeks funding from the Domestic Violence Prevention Program: Forensic Healthcare Services (DVP:FHC) to employ a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE), to be stationed in Hugo, Oklahoma. The SANE will assist both adult and pediatric patients and perform sexual assault (SA) exams as well as domestic violence exams:

WHEREAS, the maximum federal budget for Year 1 of DVP:FHC will not exceed \$250,000.00 with no required

WHEREAS the maximum federal budget for Years 1 through 5 of DVP:FHC will not to exceed \$1,250,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funds for DVP:FHC will provide education to law enforcement and other service providers about sexual assault, domestic violence, human trafficking, child abuse, and resources available.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, for the FY22 Domestic Violence Prevention Program: Forensic Healthcare Services (DVP:FHC).

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.
