RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, for the Substance Abuse and Suicide Prevention: Substance Abuse Prevention, Treatment, and Aftercare (SASP: SAPTA) grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") seeks to apply for the Substance Abuse and Suicide Prevention: Substance Abuse Prevention, Treatment, and Aftercare (SASP: SAPTA) Grant (the "Grant"). The Grant will provide a counseling program for families referred by and involved in drug court and/or child welfare services;

WHEREAS, the maximum federal budget for Year 1 of the Grant will not exceed \$400,000 with no required match;

WHEREAS the maximum federal budget for Years 1 through 5 of the Grant will not exceed \$2,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funds will staff a therapist and Prevention Specialist to facilitate the Strengthening Families curriculum as well as individual counseling as needed. Funding will allow the therapist and Prevention Specialist to attend case conferences with child welfare and to participate on drug court teams.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service for the Substance Abuse and Suicide Prevention: Substance Abuse Prevention, Treatment and Aftercare grant.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that twelve (12) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Regular Session of the Tribal Council at Tuskahoma, Oklahoma on January 8, 2022. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB- 83 -22 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of twelve (12) members, zero (0) negative votes, and zero (0) abstaining.
