RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the Department of Justice for the 2020 Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Purpose Area 5: Project EMPOWER and Purpose Area 6: Project STRONG Expansion.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant from the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), for the 2020 Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS) Purpose Area 5 (PA5) Project EMPOWER. The PA5 grant is for budget period October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023 in the amount of \$825,643. The PA5 grant purpose is to continue to support Native American victims of intimate partner violence and provide guidance in the Nation's efforts to engage in strategic planning to increase safety and meet the needs of these victims by advancing Life Plans to transform the victim to survivor. (See Exhibit A);

WHEREAS, the Nation has also been awarded a grant from DOJ OJP for the 2020 CTAS Purpose Area 6 (PA 6) Project STRONG to expand the grant provided by the Department of Health and Human Services) Project STRONG for budget period October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023 in the amount of \$463,804. The Project STRONG expansion funds provided by DOJ will provide a "one stop" advocacy center equipped with recording capabilities and space for medical exams for children who have experienced sexual assault in Pittsburg and Pushmataha Counties; and

WHEREAS, the total funds awarded by DOJ is \$1,289,447.00 with no match required.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept Eight Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Six Hundred Forty Three Dollars and 00/100 (\$825,643.00) from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, for the 2020 Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Purpose Area 5 Project EMPOWER for budget period October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill be cited as approval to accept Four Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$463,804.00) from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs for 2020 Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Purpose Area 6 Project STRONG for budget period October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023.
