RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for the Tribally Engaged Approaches to Lung Screening Subaward.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a subaward grant from the University of Oklahoma Health and Science Center (OUHSC) for the Tribally Engaged Approaches to Lung Screening (TEALS) to systematically address multi-level factors that affect implementation of a lung cancer screening program as we design and carry out a screening process responsive to the needs of our community and our health system;

WHEREAS, the Nation has been awarded the following amounts: Year 1 for budget period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020, in the amount of \$128,946 (See Exhibit A); Year 2 for budget period April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021 in the amount of \$182,867 (See Exhibit B); and Year 3 for budget period April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022 in the amount of \$189,070 (See Exhibit C);

WHEREAS, the total subaward budget for TEALS is \$500,883 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds for TEALS subaward added a scanner to the Durant Regional Medical Clinic expanding the capacity to implement lung screening. Additionally, the funds allowed the Nation to partner in community participatory research working alongside academic partners and play a major role in the planning, implementation, evaluation and dissemination of the results of TEALS according to its established research policies and procedures.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept One Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$128,946.00) from the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for Tribally Engaged Approaches to Lung Screening Subaward Year 1 for budget period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill be cited as approval to accept One Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$182,867.00) from the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for Tribally Engaged Approaches to Lung Screening Subaward Year 2 for budget period April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill be cited as approval to accept One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$189,070.00) from the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for Tribally Engaged Approaches to Lung Screening Subaward Year 3 for budget period April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill be cited as approval to accept a total of Five Hundred Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$500,883.00) from the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for Tribally Engaged Approaches to Lung Screening Subaward.
