

**TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR FY20 INDIAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
BLOCK GRANT (ICDBG)**

**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION**

**RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL**

**A COUNCIL BILL**

**TO APPROVE** the funds and budget from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the FY20 Indian Community Development Block Grant Program.

**WHEREAS**, Tribal Council approved application of the 2020 Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) in Council Bill CB-40-20;

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for budget period May 15, 2020 through April 20, 2026, in the amount of \$900,000.00 to rehabilitate low and moderate-income member housing. See Exhibit A;

**WHEREAS**, the federal budget for the FY20 ICDBG is \$900,000 with a \$900,000 required match for a total budget of \$1,800,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, funds from ICDBG provide housing rehabilitation of low-income privately owned homes, to include but not limited to: repairing or replacing electrical wiring, plumbing, foundations, roofing, insulation, air/heating systems, or handicap accessibility features within the Nation's sovereign territory.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000.00) from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.


**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to provide a match of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000.00) for a total budget of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,800,000.00) for the FY20 Indian Community Development Block Grant Program for budget period May 15, 2020 through April 20, 2026.


**CERTIFICATION**
