# IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** the funds and budget from the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families for the Preserving Elder Language: Choctaw Nation Emergency Native Language Project.

WHEREAS, Tribal Council approved application of the Emergency Grants for Native American Language Preservation and Maintenance in Council Bill CB-17-22;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Administration for Children and Families (ACF) for budget period September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022, in the amount of \$82,609 to protect the Choctaw Language by documenting the language and stories of tribal elders most at risk of the COVID-19 virus. See Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the federal budget for the Emergency Native Language Project is \$82,609 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Emergency Native Language Project will conduct interviews with elders and document and transcribe these interviews toward preserving the language and culture of the Nation.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept Eighty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Nine Dollars and 00/100 (\$82,609.00) from the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families for the Preserving Elder Language: Choctaw Nation Emergency Native Language Project for budget period September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022.

4K Video Camcorder	Two (2) 4K Video Camcorders (brand and supplier as yet unknown) are requested to record interviews with Elders. \$2,500 is requested for the purchase of the camcorders and any necessary accessories.
