IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the FY21 Hazardous Waste Management Grant Project (HWMGP).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency for budget period October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022, in the amount of \$100,000 to fund administrative and technical staff, conduct educational outreach and conduct hazardous waste collection events. See Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the federal budget for HWPDP is \$100,000 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds will be used to promote and conduct household hazardous waste collection events and provide education outreach that provides an opportunity for communities within the Tribal Sovereign Territory to dispose of household hazardous waste.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept One Hundred Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$100,000.00) from the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the FY21 Hazardous Waste Management Grant Project for budget period October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.
