TO APPROVE THE FY2023 BUDGETS FOR THE INDIAN CHILD WELFARE PROGRAM AND THE FAMILY PRESERVATION PROGRAM

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the proposed budget for the Choctaw Nation Indian Child Welfare Program as funded by Title IV-B Subpart 1 with the required tribal match for FY 2023.

TO APPROVE the proposed budget for the Choctaw Nation Family Preservation Program as funded by Title IV-B Subpart 2 with the required match for FY 2023.

WHEREAS, the purpose of Title IV-B, Subpart 1 of the Social Security Act (the "Act") is to promote Tribal and State flexibility in the development and expansion of a coordinated child and family services program that utilizes community-based agencies and ensures all children are raised in safe, loving families, by: (1) protecting and promoting the welfare of all children; (2) preventing the neglect, abuse, or exploitation of children; (3) supporting at-risk families through services which allow children, where appropriate, to remain safely with their families or return to their families in a timely manner; (4) promoting the safety, permanence, and well-being of children in foster care and adoptive families; and (5) providing training, professional development and support to ensure a well-qualified child welfare workforce;

WHEREAS, Subpart 1 of the Act allows for payment directly to the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma with an approved plan for child welfare services to achieve the goals listed above;

WHEREAS, the grant award under Title IV-B Subpart 1 for the Indian Child Welfare Program is \$586,182.00 with an in-kind tribal match of \$195,394.00;

WHEREAS, Subpart 2 of the Act provides for programs to enable States and Tribes to develop and establish, or expand, and to operate coordinated programs of community-based family support services, family preservation services, family reunification services, and adoption promotion and support services to accomplish the following objectives: (1) To prevent child maltreatment among families at risk through the provision of supportive family services; (2) to assure children's safety within the home and preserve intact families in which children have been maltreated, when the family's problems can be addressed effectively; (3) to address the problems of families whose children have been placed in foster care so that reunification may occur in a safe and stable manner in accordance with the Adoption and Safe Families Act of 1997; and (4) to support adoptive families by providing support services as necessary so that they can make a lifetime commitment to their children;

TO APPROVE THE FY2023 BUDGETS FOR THE INDIAN CHILD WELFARE PROGRAM AND THE FAMILY PRESERVATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the grant award under Title IV-B Subpart 2 for the Family Preservation Program is \$764,429.00 with an in-kind tribal match of \$254,809.00; and

WHEREAS, these budgets are for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 has and have been made in accordance with the amount of the USDA adjusted grant for the previous year (FY2022).

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for the acceptance and budget for funds allocated pursuant to Title IV-B, Subpart 1 of the Social Security Act in the amount of \$586,182.00 with an in-kind match of \$195,394 for a total budget of \$781,576.00. See Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this bill be cited as approval for the acceptance and budget for funds allocated pursuant to Title IV-B, Subpart 2 of the Social Security Act in the amount of \$764,429.00 with an in-kind tribal match of \$254,809.00 for a total budget of \$1,019,238.00.
