# IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

### RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** the application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, for the FY23 Special Diabetes Program for Indians (SDPI).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma seeks to apply for the Special Diabetes Program for Indians ("the Grant");

WHEREAS, the Grant will continue to address the prevention and treatment of diabetes in Native American communities:

WHEREAS, the maximum federal budget for Year 1 of the Grant will not exceed \$3,331,639 and there is no required match;

WHEREAS the maximum federal budget for Years 1 through 5 of the Grant will not exceed \$16,658,195; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Grant will continue the previous Special Diabetes Prevention for Indians program activities to provide continuous insulin administration and glucose monitoring, nutrition education, and dental services for patients.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to submit an application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service for the FY23 Special Diabetes Program for Indians Grant.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.
