### IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** Rescission of CB-89-22 and Approve Funding for the Renovation and/or Repurposing of Certain Areas within the Nation's Casino Resort in Durant, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Tribal Council of the Nation (the "Council") shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition, and management of tribal property;

WHEREAS, the Nation owns and operates a casino resort in Durant, Oklahoma (the "Resort Property");

WHEREAS, certain areas of the Resort Property are in need of renovation and/or need to be repurposed to better suit the needs of the business;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to renovate and/or repurpose certain areas within the Resort Property (collectively, the "Renovation Project"), which Renovation Project may take place in multiple phases;

WHEREAS, in CB-89-22, the Council approved funding for the design and construction of certain components of the Renovation Project in the total amount of up to Sixty Million Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$60,913,691);

WHEREAS, due to market factors, the design and constructions costs of the components approved under CB-89-22 have increased:

WHEREAS, the scope of the initial phase of the Renovation Project has expanded over and above what was approved in CB-89-22, and new scope of the initial phase of the Renovation Project (the "New Phase I Components") is outlined in Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to rescind CB-89-22;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to approve funding for the design and construction of the New Phase I Components, as detailed on Schedule

# TO APPROVE RESCISSION OF CB-89-22 AND APPROVE FUNDING FOR THE RENOVATION AND/OR REPURPOSING OF CERTAIN AREAS WITHIN THE NATION'S CASINO RESORT IN DURANT, OKLAHOMA

A, in the total amount of up to Eighty-Five Million Three Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars (\$85,363,827) (collectively, the "Phase I Renovation Costs"); and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to fund the Phase I Renovation Costs from unrestricted funds.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Council that CB-89-22 is hereby rescinded.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval for the funding of the Phase I Renovation Costs.

**B**E IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval that the funding for the Phase I Renovation Costs shall come from unrestricted funds.

# TO APPROVE RESCISSION OF CB-89-22 AND APPROVE FUNDING FOR THE RENOVATION AND/OR REPURPOSING OF CERTAIN AREAS WITHIN THE NATION'S CASINO RESORT IN DURANT, OKLAHOMA

<u>Purpose/Need of Council Bill</u>: Certain areas of the Durant casino resort (the "Resort Property") are outdated and in need of renovation and/or need to be repurposed to better suit the needs of the business. Funding for the renovation and/or repurposing (the "Initially Approved Renovations") of certain areas of the Resort Property was approved in CB-89-22. Since the approval of CB-89-22, the estimated costs for the Initially Approved Renovations have increased due to market changes, and the scope of the work to be done in the first phase of such renovations/repurposing have expanded. This Council Bill rescinds CB-89-22 and approves funding of the full cost of the new scope of the initial renovations/repurposing.
