Chapter 1: Hohchifo Anoli (Noun Phrases)

Lesson 1: Model I Noun Phrases

Starter: Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

Objective: Students will give the Choctaw word order by learning two-word noun phrases.

Presentation: Model I Noun Phrases

a) chukka tohbi
b) towa okchakko
c) chukfi achvffa
d) issi tuchina
a) white house
b) blue ball
c) one rabbit
d) three deer

Activity 1: Students will become familiar with Choctaw word order by repeating Model I noun phrases. Differences between Choctaw and English language word order will be noted.

Exercise 1:

The teacher will use modeled noun phrases to create new noun phrases and ask students to give the English meaning.

Exercise 2:

Students will "read" noun phrases when corresponding pictures are shown on the monitor.

Activity 2: CHOCTAW PHRASES

Students will read the Choctaw phrase and write the English meaning.

Closure: Teacher will call out noun phrases in Choctaw and students will give the English translation.
