Lesson 2: Model 2 Noun Phrases

Starter: Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather for the day in Choctaw.

Objective: Students will be introduced to the Choctaw word order by learning two word noun phrases.

Presentation: Model 2 Noun Phrases

Activity 1: Students will become familiar with Choctaw word order by repeating Model 2 Noun Phrases. Differences between Choctaw and English language word order will be noted.

Exercise 1:

The teacher will use modeled noun phrases to create new noun phrases and ask students to give the English meaning.

Exercise 2:

Students will read noun phrases when corresponding pictures are shown on the monitor.

Activity 2: CHOCTAW PHRASES II

Students will translate Choctaw noun phrases to English, and English noun phrases to Choctaw.

Closure: Teacher will call out noun phrases in Choctaw and students will give English translation.
