

### SENTENCE COMPLETION/TRANSLATION

*Using the possessive pronoun “vm-my,” complete the sentence and translate. Note: In translation you start with the possessive word.*

Example: ʋm ofi yvt nusi.      My dog is sleeping.

1. ʋm ofi yvt aboha anuka bininli tuk.      (dog)  
*My dog was sitting in the room.*
2. ʋm issuba yvt iti bilika hikia.      (horse)  
*My horse is standing near the tree.*
3. ʋm ofi yvt aboha anuka ittonla tuk.      (dog)  
*My dog was lying in the room.*
4. ʋm akaka yvt kanchuk bilika hikia.      (chicken)  
*My chicken is standing near the barn.*
5. ʋm isht ishko yvt homma micha tohbi.      (cup)  
*My cup is red and white.*
6. ʋm issi yvt iti nuta hikia.      (deer)  
*My deer is standing under the tree.*
7. ʋm okhisa yvt tiwa tuk.      (door)  
*My door was open.*
8. ʋm oka yvt kapvssa tuk.      (water)  
*My water was cold.*
9. ʋm ilefoka yvt aboha anuka ittonla.      (clothes)  
*My clothes are lying in the room.*
10. ʋm issuba yvt balila hinla.      (horse)  
*My horse can run.*
11. ʋm ikhvnanchi yvt holisso apisa ia tuk.      (teacher)  
*My teacher went to school.*
12. ʋm isht ishko yvt aiimpa pakna talaya.      (glass)  
*My glass is setting on the table.*
