Lesson 4: Model 3 Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

Objective: Students will learn Model 3 Sentences with the possessive pronoun "im - his/her/its." Students will learn that the m-form possessive pronouns are written before words that begin with a vowel.

Presentation: Model 3 Sentences

- a) Im ampo yvt iskitini.
- b) Im okhisa yvt t<u>i</u>wa tuk.
- c) Katos vt im oka ishko.
- d) Im ilefoka achefa tuk.

- a) His plate is small.
- b) Her door was open.
- c) The cat is drinking its water.
- d) (She) washed her clothes.

Activity: SENTENCE COMPLETION/TRANSLATION

Teacher will show pictures and students will provide the m-form possessive pronoun to say "his/hers/its." Repeat several times until students can quickly say the picture and pronoun together. Students will complete and translate sentences using the possessive pronoun "*im-his/her/its*."

Closure: Teacher will call on students at random to give the Choctaw possessive pronoun 'im' with the name of pictures.
