father	aki	chiki	iki
mother	svshki	chishki	ishki
brother	a nakfi	chi nakfi	i nakfi

Activity: KINSHIP PHRASES

Students will translate Choctaw kinship terms to English.

Closure: Teacher will select students to give correct meaning of words given in Choctaw.
