Activity: SENTENCE MATCHING

Students will match English sentences to its corresponding Choctaw sentences. The subject markers in Choctaw are equivalent to articles in English, “a,” “an,” and “the.” Students will look at sentences with the Choctaw basic articles.

Closure: Teacher will say vocabulary words in English and students will give the Choctaw meaning.
