- b) Katos lakna put balili kiyo. b) This yellow cat is not running.

Activity 1: The teacher will model correct pronunciation of Model 2 Sentences and students will repeat.

Activity 2: NANTA KATIOHMI?

Students will read short sentences in Choctaw and translate them into English.

Closure: The teacher will call on students to read the Choctaw sentences and give the translation.
