Lesson 3: What are you?

Starter: Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

Objective: Students will be introduced to Model 2 Sentences with vocabulary words that identifies or describes a person.

Presentation: Model 2 Sentences

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| a) ᵁlla chia ho? | a) Are you a child? |
| b) Ohoyo sipokni sia. | b) I am an old lady. |
| c) Hattak himitta sia | c) I am a young man. |

Activity 1: Students will imitate Model 2 Sentences for correct pronunciation and practice identifying themselves with *sia*.

Activity 2: TRANSLATIONS

Students will read the English sentences and write in Choctaw the correct translation. These sentences will provide review usage of 'sia' and 'chia'.

Closure: Teacher will call on students at random and have them to respond to questions by telling who they are or are not.
