**Lesson 2:** Model I Sentences

**Starter:** Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

**Objective:** Students will be introduced to Model I Sentences with subject pronouns 'li' and 'ish' and the unmarked third person pronoun.

**Activity 1:** Student will repeat these modeled sentences until they are familiar with the sentence structure changes using 'ish' and 'li.'

**Activity 2:** MULTIPLE CHOICE

Students will read the sentences and mark the correct English translation. This lesson reinforces the subject pronouns 'li' and 'ish' and the unmarked subject pronouns.

**Closure:** Teacher will read sentences randomly from the student worksheet and students will give the English or Choctaw translation.
