## Chapter 6:Hohchifo UlhtobaLesson 6:Model 3 Sentences

**Starter:** Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

**Objective:** Students will be introduced to Model 3 Sentences and the Choctaw future tense marker 'ach<u>i</u>.' To show future tense the word 'ach<u>i</u>' is added to the end of a sentence.

Example Sentence:	Ofi yvt impa.	The dog is eating.
Future Tense Sentence:	Ofi yvt impa ch <u>i</u> .	The dog will eat.

If the preceding words ends in vowel *o* or *i* then those vowels must be changed to an *a* to complete the future tense marker.

Examples:	Ofi yvt nusi.	The dog is sleeping.
	Ofi yvt nusa ch <u>i</u> .	The dog will sleep.

## Presentation: Model 3 Sentences

a) Holisso apisa ia la ch <u>i</u> .	a) I will go to school.
b) Holisso apisa ish ia ch <u>i</u> .	b) You will go to school.
c) Holisso apisa ia ch <u>i</u> .	c) (He/She/It) will go to school.

**Activity 1:** Students will repeat Model 3 Sentences until familiar with the future tense marker. Students will continue to review 'li' and 'ish' in these sentence structures.

## Activity 2: WHO WILL GO TO SCHOOL?

This activity reviews Model 3 Sentences and reinforces the future tense marker 'achi.'

**Closure:** Teacher will read sentences from student worksheet in Choctaw or English and students will read back the corresponding sentence.

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
