Lesson 7: Model 4 Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

Objective: Students will practice the use of past and future tense markers in Model 4 Sentences and learn the correct usage of 'vpa.'

Presentation: Model 4 Sentences

| a) Wak nipi vpa li. | a) I am eating beef. |
| b) Wak nipi ish vpa tuk. | b) You ate beef. |
| c) Wak nipi vpa chi. | c) (He/She/It) will eat beef. |

The teacher will provide examples of how the word 'vpa' must have a named item of food preceding it. Example: takkon vpa

Activity 1: Students will repeat Model 4 Sentences until familiar with interchanging the end of a sentence from a past tense marker to a future tense marker.

Activity 2: TRANSLATION

This translation activity provides practice in the use of past tense markers and future tense markers.

Closure: Teacher will read sentences from student worksheet at random and have students to give the corresponding translation.
