Lesson 2: Model I Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

Objective: Students will be introduced to Model I Sentences that tell the location and position of something or someone.

Presentation: Model I Sentences

Activity: WRITING RESPONSES

Students will write responses to questions in Choctaw according to the location and position pictures. Words to be reviewed are: location words *nuta* and *pakna* plus the position words *ittonla* and *bininli*.

Closure: Teacher will review the use of location and position words by asking specifically where certain named objects are in the classroom.
