d) Keyu, <u>a</u> chukka yvt lakna.
a) What is that?
b) That is my little house.
c) Is your house white?
d) No, my house is yellow.

Activity: WHAT IS THAT? - YUMMUT NANTA?/CHOCTAW STORY Students will read Choctaw sentences and choose a response to complete a question and answer written dialogue.

Closure: Teacher will call on individual students to read their written dialogue with their chosen responses.
