| b) Bennington ia tuk. | b) (He) went to Bennington. |
| c) Hattak mvt falama chi ho? | c) Will that man return? |
| d) <u>A</u> , onnakma falama chi. | d) Yes, (he) will return tomorrow. |

Activity: SENTENCE/QUESTION COMPREHENSION

Students will read the English sentence or question and choose the Choctaw sentence or question that is the correct translation.

Closure: Teacher will encourage students to verbally create sentences to tell something they want or where someone went and when he or she will return.
