Lesson 2: Model I Sentences

| c) Chipokni yvt na tvnna chim isha chi. | c) Your grandma will get material for you. |
| d) Hvshi achvffa yash anchi hvvim achonli tuk. | d) A month ago, she sewed us a quilt. |

Write the English meaning of each Choctaw word.
