- b) Your book is not very good.

c) <u>I</u> holisso yvt achukma <u>a</u>hli.

c) His book is really good.

Activity: TRANSLATIONS

Students will translate Choctaw sentences to English. This activity reinforces adverbs and adjectives.

Closure: The teacher will call on students at random to read their sentence translations.
