Lesson 2: Model I Sentences

| a) Ohoyo tuklo hosh iti nuta hinli. | b) The two women are standing under the tree. |
| c) ʋlla v̄hleha ȳvt oka anuka hiyohm̄aya. | c) The children are standing in the water. |

Activity: MATCHING

Students will match the Choctaw sentence in Column A to the English sentence in Column B.

Closure: Teacher will call out location and position words. Students will identify whether the words are singular, dual or plural.
