Lesson 6: Model 4 Sentences

| b) Takkon tuklo pvt iti mā takohli tuk. | b) The two apples were hanging on that tree. |
| c) Ilefoka lawa hosh kucha takohmaya. | c) There are a lot of clothes hanging outside. |

Activity: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Students will read Model 4 sentences and answer questions about the sentence. Students will also translate English sentences to Choctaw.

Closure: Teacher will call on students at random to give their responses written on their worksheets.
