- d) Keyu, ofi yvmmvt vmmi.
- a) This thick quilt is yours.
- b) That thin blanket is ours.
- c) Is that black dog his?
- d) No, that dog is mine.

Activity: SENTENCE CREATING &TRANSLATIONS/COMPLETING SENTENCES Students will translate sentences, create sentences and complete sentences with possessive adjectives.

Closure: The teacher will ask students to 'hold up' or 'point to' personal possessives and create a sentence using a possessive adjective word.
