Lesson 6: Model 4 Sentences

Activity: SENTENCE CREATING & TRANSLATIONS/COMPLETING SENTENCES
Students will translate sentences, create sentences and complete sentences with possessive adjectives.

Closure: The teacher will ask students to 'hold up' or 'point to' personal possessives and create a sentence using a possessive adjective word.
