- a) My father will arrive tonight.
- b) He will go to town in the morning.
- c) Did you eat at noon?
- d) I will eat this evening.

Activity: VOCABULARY WORD CLUE/SENTENCE MATCHING

Students will write correct terms for clues given in a sentence and choose correct English sentences that translate the Choctaw sentences.

Closure: Teacher will say terms for time and students will respond with either the words a.m. or p.m. to indicate the correct reference of time.
