Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

Objective: Students will be introduced to Model 2 sentences with terms that indicate various times of the day.

Activity: TRANSLATIONS/MATCHING

Students will translate sentences to English and match correct English words to Choctaw words.

Closure: Teacher will have students divide a sheet of paper in half and label one side 'ninak' and the other side 'nittak'. As the teacher calls out vocabulary words, students will write the word in its corresponding section.
