- Speaker 1: Nanta chi b̄v̄nna? *What do you want?*
- Speaker 2: Hushi pisa achukma il̄v̄pp̄a sv̄ b̄v̄nna. *I want this pretty bird.*
- Speaker 3: Ish chompa ch̄i h̄o? *Will you buy it?*
- Speaker 4: A, chompa sv̄ b̄v̄nna. *Yes, I want to buy it.*
- Speaker 5: Iskv̄li ish īshi h̄o? *Do you have money?*
- Speaker 6: A, iskv̄li īshi li. *Yes, I have money.*
- Speaker 7: Hushi homma p̄a chi b̄v̄nna h̄o? *Do you want this red bird?*
- Speaker 8: Keyu, hushi lakna m̄a sv̄ b̄v̄nna. *No, I want that yellow bird.*
- Speaker 9: Hushi lakna katohmi chi b̄v̄nna? *How many yellow birds do you want?*
- Speaker 10: Hushi hannali sv̄ b̄v̄nna. *I want six birds.*
- Speaker 11: Hushi lakna tuchina micha hushi tohbi tuchina sv̄ b̄v̄nna. *I want three yellow birds and three white birds.*
- Speaker 12: Na pakanli homma p̄v̄t pisa achukma. *This red flower is pretty.*
- Speaker 13: Na pakanli m̄a chi b̄v̄nna h̄o? *Do you want that flower?*
- Speaker 14: Keyu, na pakanli tohbi p̄a sv̄ b̄v̄nna. *No, I want this white flower.*
- Speaker 15: Ish chompa ch̄i h̄o? *Are you buying it?*
- Speaker 16: A, chompa la ch̄i. *Yes, I will buy it.*
- Speaker 17: Katomma ish ia? *Where are you going?*
- Speaker 18: Chukka ia li. *I am going home.*
- Speaker 19: Ome, chi p̄isa la chike. *Okay, I will see you.*
