d) Wak apesvchi sipokni hvchia. d) You (all) are old cowboys.

Activity: CHOCTAW RESPONSES/TRUE OR FALSE/MATCHING -SENTENCE TRANSLATIONS

Students will answer Choctaw questions in written form using the correct pronouns. Students will match Choctaw sentences to English sentences.
